In the 2010 call, the BKC went on to receive additional financing to support its activities and to</li> </ul>
	consolidate its position as the first Campus of International Excellence.
	Finally, in the new 2010 call, the campus officially known as the Health Universitat de Barcelona Campus (HUBc) was also given CIE status.
About Barcelona	Barcelona has the dynamic and open personality so typical of Mediterranean cities. Barcelona has its own way of life which makes it unique.
	<b>Barcelona's warm, pleasant climate</b> means that the locals spend a lot of time outdoors. The city's location on the shores of the Mediterranean brings pleasant temperatures, allowing Barcelona to enjoy its <b>5km</b> of perfectly equipped <b>beaches</b> all the year round, and a superb Olympic Marina which is ideal for lovers of water sports.
	Barcelona is one of the most popular university destinations chosen by students throughout the world due to its academic excellence, location and vision of the future. Students from abroad make up 11.4% of the city's academic community in <b>Barcelona</b> 's numerous <b>faculties</b> .
