
Cost of borrowing + Bank spread up to 30 years, 5 years grace

Promotes foreign direct investment (FDI) into developing countries to help support economic growth.



### Early Career Opportunities at the WBG

WBG Young Professionals
Program

- The Young Professionals Program (YPP) flagship WBG recruitment program over the last 50 years for WB and 15 years for IFC for roles in core operations.
- It includes IFC's YP Program formerly known as Global Transaction Team Program.
- Offers a comprehensive development curriculum for professionals.

WBG Analyst Program and IFC Investment
Analyst Program

- Three year Analysts Program to strategically attract and develop 28 and under early career professionals with a Bachelor's or Master's Degree and 1-3 years of experience.
- Offers a comprehensive development curriculum.
- The IFC Investment Analyst Program is focused on corporate finance.

Internship

- Opportunities to gain exposure in an international development organization while at school (Graduate programs).
- 1 4 months paid opportunity at the WB and IFC.
- Summer and Winter intake.

#### **WBG Young Professionals Program**

#### Overview

- Two-year program for WB YPs and three-year program for IFC YPs, who have a passion for international development
- Assignments in WB and IFC operations
- Opportunity to work on a global basis in multiple locations
- For IFC YPs, first assignment in Washington, DC and mandatory rotation in IFC field offices.
- Extensive development opportunities through rotations/stretch assignments, leadership development, WBG operational training, mentoring, and group coaching and career development

#### To be Eligible and Competitive

- Be 32 years or younger when applying (Be born on or after October 1, 1985) (no age limit for IFC YPs)
- For WB YP: at least, 3 years of professional or policy level experience for Master's Degrees and three years of research into a PhD degree in areas relevant to the WB's Operations such as: economics, finance, education, public health, social sciences, engineering, urban planning, and natural resource management.
- For IFC YP: 3-5 years of experience in investment banking, project finance, private equity, corporate finance, portfolio management, or financial consulting in investment/finance. International/emerging markets experience is important.
- Strong analytical, communications and negotiations skills
- Fluent in English; Desirable proficiency in one of the other WB languages: Arabic, Chinese, French, Portuguese, Russian and/or Spanish
- Apply online: WB YP website –Mid-June thru July + IFC YP website --Mid-August thru End of Sept.

# WBG Analyst and IFC Investment Analyst Programs

#### Overview

#### **WBG Analyst**

- Three-year program
- Assignments in the WBG (operation and corporate functions)
- Possibility of stretch assignments (business-driven)
- Extensive development opportunities through leadership development, mentoring, and group coaching and career development

#### **IFC Investment Analyst**

- Two-year term contracts (renewable to a maximum of four years)
- Investment analysts are an integral part of IFC Investment project teams

#### To be Eligible and Competitive

- Bachelor's and/or Master's degree in relevant field, depending on recruitment stream
- Be 28 years old or under when applying (be born on or after **January 1, 1989**)
- One to three years of work experience in the considered recruitment stream
- Analytical thinking, proven academic success, strong written and oral communications skills, and leadership potential
- Apply online: WBG Analyst Program, April 5-21, 2017
- Bachelor's or equivalent degree
- Up to 3 years of work experience in a financial institution or other finance-related field
- Strong analytical and conceptual skills including corporate/project finance
- Ability to develop complex financial models
- Keen interest in development finance and multicultural environments
- Apply online: IFC Investment Analyst, on-going.

#### **WBG** Internships

#### Overview

#### **World Bank**

- Opportunity to gain exposure in an international development organization while at school
- Two Internship sessions: Summer and Winter
- Paid Internship 1 4 months

#### **IFC**

- Opportunity to undertake discrete projects, such as investment due diligence and market/sector research
- Summer Internship session (between May and September)
- Paid Internship 1 4 months

#### To be Eligible and Competitive

- Current enrollment in a full-time graduate program with plans to return to full-time study
- Be fluent in English and knowledge of other WB languages desirable
- Managers access application database to select candidates
- Apply online:
  - Winter Internship: through October
  - Summer Internship: December through January
  - Candidates must be in the first-to-last year of an MBA or similar graduate program
  - Be fluent in English and knowledge of other WB languages desirable
  - Short-listed candidates are contacted directly by departments for interviews
  - Apply online: December through Mid-January

# How should you approach your WBG job search?





- Visit the World Bank Group website and familiarize yourself with the institution and the areas of your interest
- Participate (actively/passively) in WB/IFC blogs ... you will get to know the main players in some areas
- Tap into your University network through Career Center, Professors, alumni association
- Work on your CV (make it concise and include internships, volunteer work, skills, etc.)
- Keep an updated professional LinkedIn profile
- Apply to Programs, search for jobs or short-term consultancies in the WB/IFC careers pages or through different networks
